We are so blessed at Mt. Sinai ! With a membership of 79 families, we enjoy the talent and wisdom of many successful corporations. Diversified in Judaic religious practice, professional backgrounds and independent thinking, our Board of Directors continues to demonstrate a commitment to the future of our Congregation. The Board was courageous in their decision to adopt a budget for this year that will not force the liquidation of savings or investments. They were also optimistic in their vote to re-evaluate our financial picture in six months. The truth is that all of us want a Rabbi to reside in Cheyenne , but are all of us willing to participate so that it can happen?

Here's a thought.....If we divide the proposed annual expenses by 365 days, it costs about \$225.00 per day to cover the cost of our daily operations. This per day figure does include a small salary for the Religious Leader. As a Mitzvah, consider making a donation to cover a day or so of our operation costs. With your permission, we welcome the opportunity to recognize your initiative and generosity. And think about this.....if just half of our membership, about forty (40) families donate one days' cost, we will have an additional \$9,000.00 available to hire a Rabbi for the Mt. Sinai Congregation!
